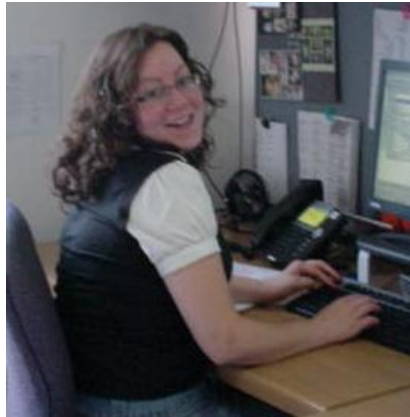

- *Dawn and Angel will review receipts for Stacey Stubinski

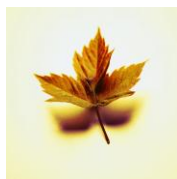
New Business:
